What's new in ITU Telecom World 2009

– **Dynamic Africa**

- New generation of telecom regulators

– **ICT is a social tool** = Mobile phone is a life infrastructure in developing countries; daily payments, health services, education, etc.

- And is transforming lives of poor people, or « unbanked ». Money from under the mattress to SIM card
- These movements will be irreversible.
